


I remember a time before finding recovery in Overeaters Anonymous when I was especially miserable during these hot and humid days. In the summer of 1981, at age sixteen, I had stopped weighing myself when I tipped the 200 pound mark. Cute, plus size clothes were not around yet and my daily "uniform" was a dark, navy blue skirt with an elastic waistband topped with a plain shirt *or* navy, velour sweat pants with a dark t-shirt. The excess weight and dark clothes made being outside in the heat especially difficult, yet I still felt an insane urge to binge whenever possible.

It was especially shaming to keep getting larger and more physically uncomfortable knowing that high school would begin in a few weeks. The psychological noose around my neck felt tighter and tighter knowing I only had a couple of weeks left to diet and get "thin!" The school I attended required after school athletics which just fueled my anxiety and discomfort. Having to wear shorts and participate in after school sports at 200 plus pounds was beyond humiliating.

What a miracle and gift it is today to experience the immeasurable blessings of daily living a 12 Step Program. OA has taught me to accept life on life's terms and let me tell you, life's terms are far better than the terms/bondage of compulsive overeating ...even during "the dog (and cat) days of summer!"

Dear 4th Stepper,

There is not a perfect way to complete the 4th Step, but it is paramount to recovery to pick a format and complete it. Some members complete more than one 4th and 5th Step before working the "maintenance" steps ... 10, 11, and 12. A member cannot go wrong just using the basic format in the AA Big Book, 4th Edition pg. 65, but there are also helpful formats and guide questions in the OA literature as well.
