- Action Item Update:
 - Radio Advertisements:
 - The committee chose 105.3 The Buzz as the radio station on which we'll air a 30-second commercial.
 - The Buzz was one of the most cost-effective radio stations we looked at.
 - It will still reach a large audience (>51K monthly), with a significant female audience, aged 25-54.
 - The cost for a 10-week radio campaign will be \$2,350.
 - We will get 25 commercials per week, spread over 7 days.
 - We will run the ad the first 4 weeks of January, then go 2 weeks on, one week off, until the week of March 25th, 2023.
 - The committee met to brainstorm what the 30-second ad should say, taking pieces from existing ads on oa.org and adding additional statements.
 - We are working with Audacy (the company that owns The Buzz) to determine how best to create the ad. The hope is to get the ad created by the end of the month, before the current committee chair's term ends.
 - The Intergroup needs to decide whether to sign up for the Great Plains Diabetes Live Well with Diabetes Health Fair on Saturday, November 4th from 8 am–12:30 pm at The Wichita State Metroplex, 5015 E 29th St N. The cost for a booth is \$75.
 - We have sufficient quantities of pamphlets, bookmarks, etc. So we won't need to order more for a while.
 - Another upcoming event is the WSU Wellness Expo, which is usually held in late February or early March.
 - The use of the OA logo on our booth will need to be renewed before February 13th, 2024.
 - The committee is still looking for a new committee chair.

AD HOC NEWCOMER CHAIR: MARY B

The only thing I have to mention is that when our Radio Advertisement occurs in December I would like to have a newcomers meeting in place. I learned that Ks. City is holding a weekly newcomers meeting via Zoom weekly.

I plan on attending that to see how it works for them. Perhaps we can do something similar.

OA REALIGNMENT COMMITTEE: LEE ANN Y

Due to the dissolution of Region 4, I set up a new committee at the last Intergroup Board Meeting. The 1st meeting of the ad hoc Realignment Committee will be tomorrow night (Aug 22nd) from 6:00 to 6:30 PM. Any member of the Midcontinent Intergroup (i.e., you) may join this committee at any time. The temporary committee's purpose is to research various Regions, figuring out the process Midcontinent needs for changing Regions and reporting back to the Board. This committee will also be responsible for communication to Midcontinent's Fellowship and other duties assigned by the Chair related to the Realignment.

Currently it is scheduled to meet every month 2 weeks after the Board Meeting. When necessary, we might meet more often, longer or use a hybrid meeting. If we meet in person it will be at the Mt. Vernon Church
